2018 was both a very exciting and challenging year for the Village! As with all significant progress, a little bit of challenge usually emerges, especially when you renovate a 50-year old campus! As I look back on this, I'm so thankful for the dedication of our staff as we instituted these projects and for our residents and their families as they tolerated some interruptions in their normal routines.

As the year ended, the interior of our Lodge lobby, completely renovated, was re-opened. We also moved four residents in Residential Care to brand-new, gorgeous rooms that are much more accessible and comfortable. This area of the Village has never been renovated, and it was the most in need. These residents also began to enjoy the newly renovated and furnished Activity and Dining areas, and most importantly, we were able to open up a brand-new Nurses' Station, bringing the staff closer to the residents.

While all of these wonderful projects progressed, we had several surprises with plumbing infrastructure that had to be addressed immediately. These projects were unanticipated expenses in our annual budget, but in the long run they provided some very important updates to the campus. We also made some necessary improvements to our generator, and we expect more electrical improvements in the coming months as well.

As always, we thank you for choosing Presbyterian Village. There are many retirement communities and nursing facilities in Little Rock, and we appreciate your confidence in us. We believe our greatest strength, throughout the years, continues to be the unique atmosphere and commitment to true community—among staff, resident, and families—that we nurture and sustain. The remainder of 2019 will be equally exciting as we complete the Lodge entrance renovations and the remaining Residential Care rooms. VILLAGE PARTNERS WITH TWO LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS FOR EDUCATIONAL FILMS

On June 6, the Village and LifeQuest of Arkansas hosted a documentary film screening, *Alive Inside*, which chronicles the stories of those living with dementia and the providers working to improve their lives. Specifically, the film features the role of music therapy for those living with dementia.

"We have hoped to show this film for a few years. In 2015, we became a certified Music and Memory provider, which is the program featured in the film. When we started, and still today, the Village is just a handful of skilled nursing centers in our state to offer this wonderful therapy. The Village Chapel has given us the opportunity to show the film and share the program with a wider audience," said Chris Marsh, Executive Director.

In November, Alzheimer's Arkansas hosted a screening of the very touching film, *Still Alice*, also in our Village Chapel. The film tells the story of a woman with early-onset dementia from her point of view as the person with the diagnosis. The Alzheimer's Arkansas staff also led a discussion of the film and early-onset dementia concluding the screening.

Both events were well attended and provided great educational opportunities about issues very specific to aging.

VILLAGE WELCOMES NEW MEDICAL DIRECTOR TO OUR HEALTH CARE CENTER



Please join us in welcoming a new Medical Director to Presbyterian Village. Dr. Priya Mendiratta oversees the medical needs of both long-term care and short-term rehabilitation residents of our Health Care Center.

Dr. Priya Mendiratta is a geriatrician at UAMS and she sees patients in the Thomas and Lyon Longevity Clinic at the Donald W. Reynolds Institute on Aging. She will be on-site twice a week at the Village to work with our staff. Her work is aided by Janet Radar, Physician Assistant, who has been on-site here at the Village for several years through our arrangement with UAMS. We are thankful for the geriatrics services that our UAMS team provides our residents and their families. Welcome Dr. Mendiratta!

RESIDENT KINDNESS CREW SERVES LOCAL COMMUNITY

Our Village Kindness Crew sponsored two food-packing “parties” last summer to benefit students at nearby McDermott Elementary School. The bags of food were used for a special summer school program for students at the school.

They also continued with their compassion blanket ministry to benefit the Palliative Care program at UAMS, and they organized a special blessing ceremony to present the blankets to the program.

The Kindness Crew continues to work at Grace Presbyterian Church monthly to pack food bags for the church’s food pantry. We are thankful for our friends at Grace for providing

our residents the opportunity to participate in their community feeding ministries.

The Kindness Crew was first organized in 2017 through start-up funding provided by Presbytery of Arkansas. Chaplain Stacey Hammons oversees the program.
